

Privacy Notice for Suppliers

MJ Gleeson plc and its associated companies and undertakings (“Gleeson”) is committed to respecting your privacy.

Please read the following notice to understand how your information will be treated. This notice may change from time to time so please check it regularly.

This Gleeson privacy notice applies to all personal information that you or a third party provide to us.

By providing Gleeson with information or using our website you agree to be bound by this notice in respect of the personal information collected about you.

Data Protection

As a data controller we take data protection seriously and comply with all relevant legislation when handling any personal information given or received from you or third parties.

This is the personal data we collect

We may collect some or all of the following information:

- The name of your business
- Name
- Address
- NI number
- Unique tax reference number
- Bank account details
- Insurance certificates
- Telephone contact number/numbers
- Email address
- Your date of birth
- Signature
- Correspondence between us
- Photographs and video images

This is how we collect your personal data

- When you contact us by phone, email or letter
- When we obtain information on you or your company from the Internet or social media profiles such as LinkedIn
- When you view our website and submit your information through our web enquiry form
- When you request further information about our products and services and send your personal data to us
- When you telephone a Gleeson representative to enquire about a potential business opportunity, providing a service or product for use in our business
- When you provide us with information about you and your business during our supplier assessment process
- Via closed circuit television cameras

This is why we collect your personal data

- To assess your suitability as a supplier of goods or services to Gleeson and to progress your enquiry to placing an order
- To assess the suitability of your land for residential or commercial development
- To manage our contractual obligations to you and your business or your contractual obligations to Gleeson and to be able to contact you when we need to
- To inform future business strategies and development solutions
- To notify you about changes to our products or services.
- To tell you about any releases or new developments that may be of interest to you or your business.
- To satisfy any legal obligations including Anti-Money Laundering and taxation obligations
- To support marketing campaigns
- For the purpose of maintaining security and for crime prevention
- To provide to residents of a Gleeson Homes development as part of our YourWatch® service

This is how we use your personal data

- To ensure we are able to contact you to discuss any commercial arrangements we may enter in to with you
- To assess the suitability of you or your business as a supplier to Gleeson
- To make payments to you or your business and to make any deductions required by tax law
- To comply with Anti-Money Laundering rules.
- To contact you in the future
- To send you information and notification of our current and future requirements for services, products or land

This is how we share your personal data

We may share your personal data within the Gleeson group of companies.

We may share your information with Approving Bodies, Consultants, Utility Companies, Water Authorities, NHBC or HMRC but will only share your information where it relates to the service or product you are supplying to us.

Under limited circumstances, your personal information may be disclosed to third parties as permitted by, or to comply with, applicable laws and regulations, for instance, when responding to subject access requests, proceedings of a court of law or similar legal process, to protect against fraud, and to otherwise cooperate with law enforcement or regulatory authorities.

This is why we are we allowed to process your personal data and for how long

We are allowed to process your personal data where we:

- are entering into or have entered into a contract with you;
- have a legal obligation to process your personal data (for example where required to deduct tax from payments); and/or
- have a legitimate business interest in processing your personal data and that interest does not impact your rights and freedoms as a data subject, for example because you have expressed an interest in supplying goods or services to Gleeson.

We may hold data on subcontractors and material suppliers for up to 6 years from the later of when we sold a house related to the supply or when services or materials were last supplied.

We may hold data on landowners, agents and other suppliers for up to 15 years from the later of the last supply or when we sold a house related to the supply, in case any claim is made by a warranty provider.

If we are promoting your land through the Gleeson Strategic Land division or are an agent we may keep data for up to 3 years unless we have entered in to a contractual arrangement with you in which case your data will be kept for 6 years following the year in which any obligations between us have been settled.

Data processed for statutory reasons (for example tax and anti-money laundering) will be held until the statutory obligation to do so has been reached.

Storage of your personal data

We will store digital or hard copy data on our premises or it may be transferred to a secure third party facility for storage. We will keep your information secure by taking appropriate technical and organisational measures.

Your personal data may be processed both within the European Economic Area ("EEA") and outside the EEA. If we process your personal data at a destination outside the EEA we confirm that we have appropriate contracts in place with any third parties based outside the EEA to ensure your data is processed in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

Your Rights

Gleeson wants to keep your personal information up to date but will rely on you to advise us if any of the information given has changed.
